Thank you for your email and for clarifying that you are seeking a formal response to your reuse request made under the Reuse of Public Sector Information Regulations 2015.

I apologise for any confusion caused by our earlier correspondence.

I can confirm that Norwich City Council permits the reuse of all information disclosed to you on 22 April 2026 in response to FOI request PN10433823 (Council Tax property list), under the terms of the Open Government Licence v3.0.
